Intra-European bank transfers to NINO, Leiden

Payments from a bank account in one country to a bank account in another country are **free of charge** in most of Europe. Requirements are:

- both countries are part of the Single European Payments Area (**SEPA**) – a list of participating countries can be found at www.thesepadirectory.org/countries;
- the payment is made in **euros**;
- when making the payment, the sender provides his bank with the **IBAN** (International Bank Account Number) of the beneficiary – this number serves as identification of the bank account holder, including his bank and country of residence;
- when making the payment, the sender provides his bank with the **BIC** (Bank Identifier Code) of the beneficiary's bank – this code (sometimes called SWIFT address or SWIFT code) indicates the address of the beneficiary's bank.

you will need the following information.
